# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION BETWEEN

Department of commerce & management

Dr. C. V. Raman university, kargi road, kota, bilaspur

AND

#### Department of commerce and management

### G. B. Murarka arts and commerce college, shegaon, district: buldana, Maharashtra

Department of Commerce & Management (DCM) Dr. C. V. Raman University, Kargi Road Kota, Bilaspur, and Department of Commerce and Management G. B. Murarka arts and commerce college, Shegaon, District: Buldana, Maharashtra wishing to establish academic relation with their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation, agree to corporate with each other as follows. Subject to mutual consent, the areas of Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU). Department of Commerce & Management, Dr. C. V. Raman University and Department of commerce and management G. B. Murarka arts and Commerce College, Shegaon, District: Buldana, Maharashtra agrees:

- To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes,
- 2. To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- 3. To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- 4. To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, faculty and students for limited periods of time for purpose of education and/or research.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoU for Cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both institutions, prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such MoUs entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MoU for Cooperation. Both institutions hereby agree on the following articles to establish the Exchange Program.

#### I. STUDENT EXCHANGE

- 1. The term of study for exchange students participating in this program shall be one academic year, but may be extended with the consent of both the Departments.
- The total number of mutual exchange students will be about same from each Department during the term of five years.
- The university and college has the right to decide acceptance of exchange students, by taking account of recommendation issued from the home university for exchange students based on their academic record.
- The host Department shall reserve or make available accommodation on campus for exchange students or assist them in locating suitable housing off campus if they so desire.
- The exchange student is treated as either the research student or specially registered student.
- The exchange students will be subject to the student rules at the host university and college, while on exchange. Exchange students will be offered the same facilities as local students.
- Exchange students will study subjects or conduct researches which are pertinent to their field of study and are offered by the host Department.
- 8. The acceptance of course work (lectures, seminars) taken at the host university and college to measure of achievement attained there will be communicated to the home Department.
- Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Departments

## II. FACULTY EXCHANGE

- 1. The two Departments will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange for mutual agreed periods.
- Faculty exchange may assume various forms, such as individual short-time and long term visits of faculties, joint research and developmental projects.
- 3. Encouragement of the academic faculty to co-author publications, joint research activities and joint project possibilities is in subject to applicable copyright as well as rules and regulations of the perspective Department.

- 4. The host Department will endeavor to, as much as possible; make available such facilities that will enable the faculty to obtain experience and training in its departments and institutes, including the use of its libraries.
- Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Departments.

#### III. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

 Information will be actively exchanged, including information on research and study provided at the Department, relevant information about faculty members and fields of research, and Department publications.

#### TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION

- · Provide academic interaction by delivering expert lectures.
- Invitation letter for guest lecturers shall be given to the teachers at least 15 days in advance.
- · Provide the platform to share and exchange of best practices.
- A continuing quality improvement programmes to improve the quality of teaching.
- To facilitate the training and career Enhancement program
- To facilitate the exchange program of staff, students and interns.

#### COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty. To the programs on behalf of both parties further, a coordination committee consisting of programs coordinator from the side of Dr. C. V. Raman University and a programme's from the side of that will be periodically reviewed and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

#### CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Both institutes do not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

#### VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in from for a period of five years, commencing effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

#### **TERMINATION**

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution, once terminated neither of the institutions will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, both the institutions of this memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

# AMEMDMENTS / MODIFICATIONS

The MOU may amend or modified by a written agreement signed by the representative of both institutes.

#### DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case there will be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation head, Department of Commerce & Management, Dr. C. V. Raman University and Department of Commerce & Management G. B. Murarka Arts and Commerce college, Shegaon, District: Buldana, Maharashtra will resolve with mutual consent.
